## Registration Information

### REGISTRATION BEGINS: MARCH 3, 2008

1. Registrations are taken at the Indian Valley Family YMCA Membership Office (during business hours only) located at 890 Maple Avenue, Harleysville.
2. Registrations **MUST** be completed in person. We cannot accept over the phone, fax registrations, or registrations via mail.
3. All campers are required to be a North Penn YMCA member. If they are not a member, a membership can be purchased at time of registration.
4. Registration are on a first come, first serve basis, and all camps are limited in size.
5. Campers are grouped according to their grade as of September, 2008.
6. When registering please bring the following: Insurance information, emergency contact information form, and registration forms as provided in this brochure. Incomplete paperwork may result in the delay of your child's registration.
7. Deposit payments are due at the time of registration ( See Payment Policy). ***Make Checks Payable to the North Penn YMCA.***

### Financial Assistance

The YMCA strives to serve everyone in the community, regardless of their individual economic circumstances. Camp financial assistance applications are available at the YMCA Membership Office and must be submitted with completed camp paperwork by May 23, 2008.

## Payment Procedures and Policies

1. **A \$25.00 non-refundable deposit per session per child is required at time of registration. This deposit will be credited toward the camp session fee.**
2. **Balances MUST BE RECEIVED BY OUR OFFICE 7 days prior to Camp Session Start Date and turned in no later than 8:00 p.m., please see Payment schedule for clarification on page 8 of Camp Parent Handbook.**
3. Balances less deposits are refundable up to the Payment in Full Date.
4. There are no refunds after the Payment in Full Date.
5. All past due accounts will be assessed a \$30.00 late payment fee after the due date.
6. If an account goes two weeks past due, the Indian Valley Family YMCA reserves the right to withdrawal your child(ren) from our summer camp sessions due to delinquent accounts.
7. The Indian Valley Family YMCA reserves the right to report any delinquent accounts over 60 days past due to a credit collection agency.
